# **2015 Silverwood - Suggested Packing List**

### BRING SACK LUNCH for Friday, May 29- No nut products

- Extra spending money Optional recommended approximately \$10-20 (see below):
   <u>OPTIONAL</u>: Snacks/souvenirs at Silverwood (\$10-\$20 suggested). (All entrance fees and meals covered by student fees for Triple Play and Silverwood Theme parks. This amount only suggested for food/purchases made at student discretion.)
- Small daypack/backpack/shoulder sack (to carry lunch/snacks, towel, layers of clothing, water bottle)
- Concert dress clothing and black shoes Parents: see attached for requirements. Please pack Concert Performance Attire near the top of items in suitcase as chaperones will have them verify they have their full attire before departure.
- Instrument, instrument supplies (reeds, oil, swabs), and <u>sheet music</u>
- Personal snacks
- Bathing Suit --- appropriate for school function. Any students wearing inappropriate or overly
  revealing suits will be asked to put on a t-shirt and/or shorts at the discretion of the directors.
- Towel to take to waterpark.
- Toiletries and sunscreen
- Change of clothes for two days, keeping in mind that you are representing JAMS and must follow the Jane Addams dress code. Appropriate attire is up to the discretion of the music directors.
- Rain proof jacket
- Warm coat or heavy fleece sweater
- Umbrella (collapsible only), if rain is forecast
- Book
- Plastic water bottle (for bus ride and Theme Park)
- Earplugs (optional)
- Sleeping Bag/Sleep Sack (optional): Some students feel more comfortable using these on shared beds.
- Peppermint candy (optional sometimes helps with motion sickness.)
- DVD Movies to watch on the bus or in rooms (PG-13 or lower rating ONLY)

## **Additional Notes:**

- Please pack a SMALL suitcase or bag. Space is limited in the rooms and in the bus luggage areas. Students may carry a backpack onto the bus.
- Label suitcase/bag, backpack, instrument, sleeping bag with student name and phone number.

- Out of concern for students with serious allergies to all nuts, we would appreciate it if students **pack a peanut/nut-free sack lunch on Friday**. Snacks will be provided throughout the weekend. Students with severe food allergies are encouraged to bring some of their own as well.
- **Students should not bring large sums of money or valuables.** Students, staff and chaperones cannot spend time searching for lost items such as cell phones.
- Teachers and chaperones will be collecting students' phones at night, during performances and any other times deemed appropriate.

## **JAMS Music Concert Attire**

#### Senior band, Orchestra, and Choir students: Boys

- Clean, well-fitted, pressed white shirts (not ivory), not wing-collar, with white buttons; no stripes, no buttonthrough collars; (can be purchased at the Northgate Tux shop [20% discount on new items for JAMS students] or any other store of your choosing).
- Black dress pants
- Black dress shoes/Black socks
- Black ties between 1.5" and 2.5".

#### Senior band, Orchestra, and Choir students: Girls

- black dress shirt/blouse with 3/4 sleeves or longer
- black dress shoes (No sandals or open toes. A moderate (2") heel is OK, but must also be black. No platforms.)
- black dress pants or skirts (skirts MUST cover knees completely when seated just to be precise, the skirt
  must reach the tuberosity of the tibia and cellists should have even longer skirts. (Girls who do not adhere
  to this guideline will not perform.)

#### We want our students to look sharp on stage at performances!

Clothes must be clean and pressed - no wrinkles. Shirts must be tucked in. Girls' blouses may be left untucked if designed to be worn that way. Black flat closed-toed dress shoes are required. Hair must be pulled back out of face and away from instrument.

#### **Festival Attire**

As a representative of Jane Addams Middle School, students are expected to adhere to the above expectations for concert attire for all festival performances. While traveling, students are expected to dress appropriately, as school dress code rules apply for students while in hotels, at dinner, in public spaces, attending workshops, etc.
